PRESIDENT REPORT

I am sure everyone is aware of the damage done to the dam on the pond just north of the clubhouse from the recent rains. The KCC Board has formed a committee to review and recommend to the board the best solution to repair the damage. The committee will be considering long-term remedies as well as financial aspects of the different options. Some options being considered are:

1. Repair the dam and leave the pond as is.
2. Build a new dam inside the current dam and reduce the slope of the dam so it can be maintained properly.
3. Build a new dam and enlarge the pond to the north to provide an additional water source.

Other projects being considered by the committee are improving some or all of the sand traps, and updating the heating and cooling systems for the clubhouse dining room. We are renting the dining room much more often than in the past which creates more revenue but we are continually having complaints that the room is too hot.

None of these projects are in the current budget. Of course we could not anticipate the damage to the dam and it must be fixed. There isn't sufficient revenue generated to support the other projects. Options are being considered to finance these projects.
